

Travel Advisory for Indian Nationals Travelling to Lithuania

Indian nationals travelling to Lithuania are advised to ensure compliance with Lithuanian immigration laws and Schengen Visa regulations before undertaking their journey.

Travellers should ensure that they possess:

- A valid passport with sufficient validity;
- A valid visa or Temporary Residence Permit or Residence permit, as applicable;
- Adequate financial means to support their stay;
- Proof of accommodation in Lithuania;
- Return/onward travel arrangements, where applicable; and
- Supporting documents relating to the purpose of travel.

Indian nationals holding a Temporary Residence Permit (TRP) or visa are advised to strictly adhere to the authorised period of stay and complete any required extension or renewal formalities before expiry. Remaining in Lithuania beyond the permitted period of stay may result in legal action, including administrative measures or deportation, as per Lithuanian immigration laws.

Travellers should not engage with agents or intermediaries offering illegal routes or unauthorised arrangements for entry into Lithuania. Attempted illegal border crossings may lead to detention, legal proceedings, and restrictions on future travel.
