Extension of Visa/e-Visa and Waiver of Overstay Penalty for Lithuanian Nationals Stranded in India due to the Ongoing Developments in West Asia

The Government of India has decided to implement the following measures as a goodwill and humanitarian gesture for Lithuanian nationals, in view of the ongoing conflict situation in West Asia:

1. All types of Visas/e-Visas expiring or due to expire shortly may be extended for one month on a gratis basis for affected nationals by the jurisdictional Foreigners Regional Registration Offices (FRROs) on a case-to-case basis.
2. Penalty for any overstay by affected foreign nationals after 28 February 2026 (commencement of the conflict) will be waived.
3. Exit permits will be issued to affected foreign nationals on a gratis basis.
4. Non-application for exit permits or visa extension by affected foreign nationals during this period will not be treated as a violation of immigration regulations.
5. A Temporary Landing Permit (TLP) will be granted on a gratis basis to Lithuanian nationals arriving in India due to diversion of flights.
